Honoured sir,

As per the orders of the Director General, ACB, AP, Hyderabad, vide Memo in CNo. 14/RE-ATP/2016, dt.13.05.2016, a regular Enquiry was conducted on the allegations of Corruption against the officials of Sri Nettikanti Anjaneya swamy vari Devasthanam, Kasapuram, Anantapur District.

During the enquiry, Sri C.Bhaskara Reddy, the then Deputy Supdt. of Police, ACB, Anantapur Range, Anantapur, examined the witnesses and obtained their written statements and also collected documentary evidence from the concerned department.

The Regular Enquiry revealed that, 1) Sri V.Dhanunjaya, Asst. Executive Officer, Sri Nettikanti Anjaneyaswamy vari Devasthanam, Kasapuram, now working in Sri Bramaramba Mallikarjuna Swamy Devasthanam, Srisailam. 2) Sri N.Sreehari, Superintendent, Sri Nettikanti Anjaneyaswamy vari Devasthanam, Kasapuram, now working in Sri Bramaramba Mallikarjuna Swamy Devasthanam, Srisailam and 3) Sri J.Krishnam Raju @ Krishna, Junior Assistant (O/S), Sri Nettikanti Anjaneyaswamy vari Devasthanam, Kasapuram were committed the following corruption activities.

Sri V.Dhanunjaya, Asst. Executive Officer and Sri N.Sreehari, Superintendent demanded and accepted the bribe amount of Rs. 1.50 lakhs from two outsourcing archaks namely Sri R.V.Sravan and Sri T.Bharath kumar for forwarding the proposals to the Head Office and to get favorable orders for regularizing their services.

Sri V.Dhanunjaya, Asst. Executive Officer and Sri N.Sreehari, Superintendent demanded and accepted the bribe amount of Rs. 4.20 lakhs from seven (7) Dasari Servants (Rs. 60,000/- each) for processing their file to their Head Office for implementing time scales to the above contract workers but not implemented the time scales.


Sri V.Dhanunjaya, Asst. Executive Officer and Sri N.Sreehari, Superintendent demanded and accepted bribe amount of Rs. 1.20 lakhs from 40 outsourcing employees (Rs. 3,000/- each) through Sri J.M.Krishnam Raju, Junior Assistant (O/S) of temple for not processing the file regarding calling new tenders for outsourcing agencies and to continue the existing outsourcing employees and also for enhancement of their remuneration.

As the acts of Sri V.Dhanunjaya, Asst. Executive Officer, Sri N.Sreehari, Superintendent and Sri J.M.Krishnam Raju, Junior Assistant (O/S) of temple in accepting bribe amounts from the staff of the temple and other outsourcing employees working in Sree Nettikanti Anjaneya swamy temple, Kasapuram for regularizing their services and to enhance their salary/wages, established prima-facie against them, it was recommended for prosecution under the provisions of PC Act, 1988 in the Regular Enquiry Report.

Basing on Regular Enquiry report, the Director General, A.C.B., A.P., Vijayawada permitted to register a case against SO's 1 to 3 under Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 vide Memo in C.No. 14/RE-ATP/2016-S-14, dt: 11.08.2017.

As the above mentioned Report contains the ingredients of criminal misconduct against 1) Sri V.Dhanunjaya, Asst. Executive Officer, 2) Sri N.Sreehari, Superintendent and 3) Sri J.M.Krishnam Raju, Junior Assistant (O/S) of Sri Nettikanti Anjaneyaswamy vari Devasthanam, Kasapuram, I registered the same as a case in Cr.No. 5/RCO-ATP/2017 u/s 7, 13(2) r/w 13(1)(a) & (d) of PC Act, 1988 r/w 34 IPC of ACB, Anantapur Range, Ananthapur against the Accused Officers mentioned in column No.7 of FIR and took up investigation.
