Honoured Sir,

It is to submit that Dr. Pamu Panddurunga Rao, S/o Sambaiah, age 58 years (Accused Officer), Engineer-in-Chief (ENC), Public Health Department, Govt. Of A.P., R/o Flat No. B-108, Gowtham Towers, Navodaya Colony, Tadepalli Village and Mandal, Guntur District, is working as Engineer-in-chief, Public Health Department, A.P.

The Accused Officer is native of Kotcherla Village, Kalidindi Mandal, Krishna district. SO's father Sri Pamu Sambaiah was a small farmer and expired about 20 yrs back. His mother Smt. P. Rangamma is house wife. The S.O. got married to Smt. Pamu Rajya Lakshmi D/o Sri Natta Rajeswara Rao n/o Pedamaddali village, Pamarru mandal, Krishna district and blessed with two sons namely Mr. Pamu Suneel, 29 years, and Mr. P.Sudheer, 26 years, completed B. Tech and preparing for civil services.

He pursued M.E., Ph.D., L.L.B and joined in Government Service on 16.04.1987 as Deputy Executive Engineer and was promoted as Executive Engineer in the year 2000, eventually promoted as Superintendent Engineer, Chief Engineer and now promoted and working as Engineer in Chief (ENC), Public Health Department, Govt. Of A.P. since 2010. He worked as Deputy Executive Engineer at ENC Public health, Dy. Chief Engineer & Additional Commissioner at MCH, Hyderabad, Chief Engineer at GVMC.

During his service i.e., since joining in the department from 1987 to 2017 he had acquired assets by dubious means and illegal practices in shape of Flats, houses and open plots all worth of Rs. 4,08,85,781/- which are held in his name and in his family members.

His income from the different sources during the said period approximately arrived at Rs. 1,50,00,000/- and his expenditure during the said period under different heads was approximately arrived at Rs. 84,00,000/-.

As seen from the income and expenditure, there is a likely savings of Rs. 66,00,000/- (Income – Expenditure). As against the likely savings of Rs. 66,00,000/-, Dr Pamu Panddurunga Rao (A.O) is in possession of assets worth Rs. 4,08,85,781/-. Thus, Dr. Pamu Panddurunga Rao (A.O) is in possession of assets which are disproportionate to the known sources of his income to a tune of Rs. 3,42,85,781/- (Assets – likely savings) for which he cannot satisfactorily account for, and thereby he committed an offence punishable U/s 13(1)(e) r/w 13 (2) of P.C. Act 1988.

The Joint Director (R), Anti-Corruption Bureau, A.P., Vijayawada vide proceedings No. 11 /JD(R)-ACB/2017, dt. 21-06-2017 has accorded permission authorizing A. Ramadevi, Dy. Supt. of Police, CIU, ACB, A.P., Vijayawada to register a case against Dr Pamu Panddurunga Rao, S/o Sambaiah, age 58 years (Accused Officer), Engineer-in-Chief (ENC), Public Health Department, Govt. Of A.P., U/s 13(1)(e) r/w 13 (2) of P.C.Act.1988 and to investigate it.
