Honoured Sir,

I am to state that on credible information is received to the following effect Sri. Mutyalapati ChinnaVeeraiah working as Head Constable No.1906 (Civil) at Brahmangari Mattam Police Station, YSR District while working as public servant, has acquired disproportionate of assets to his known sources of income to the tune of Rs.**68,17,000/-** by indulging corrupt practices.

The suspect officer hails from middle class family. He is native of Proddatur town YSR District. He is having two male children by name M.Vinod Kumar, 27Y, completed B.Tech, M.Veerendra, 25y, Completed B.Tech and one daughter by name M.Jeevitha. The SO's daughter is given in marriage to Sri E.Sankar, who is working as software engineer and both are living in Bengaluru.

Further, the SO got married to Smt. Ramanamma of Chiyypadu Village of Chapadu Mandal. The SO's father in law worked as barber and is no more. The brother-in-law is living as Auto Driver. The SO's wife has no ancestral properties.

The Suspect Officer worked as Home Guard from 1988 to 1993. Later he was selected as Civil Police Constable on 15.8.1993 in YSR District. He worked as Police Constable in Lakkireddypalli P.S., Rayachoty P.S., Proddatur Taluk P.S. He was suspended on 6.5.2004 on the allegation of for accepting illegal gratification of Rs.3000/- from Sri S.Palakondrayudu, TDP contesting candidate of Rayachoty Assembly constituency on 28.4.2004 and then reinstated on 19.7.2004 and awarded PPI for a period of 3 years without effect. Later he got promotion as Head Constable in the year 12.10.2013. Presently he is working as Head Constable at Bramhamgari Matam Police Station, YSR District. The Suspected officer indulged in corrupt practices and acquired assets which are disproportionate to his known sources of income.

He is having the reputation of a corrupt officer and he was found amassed huge assets by illegal and corrupt means after the date of his entry into Government service, and found to have acquired assets both movable and immovable worth Rs.**68,17,000/-** disproportionate to his known sources of income at Proddatur and Kadapa of YSR District.
